A teacher of Mathematics by name Arun Raut at Jagruti Mahavidyalaya taught elementary mathematics to his son and due to his vision, Aditya did splendid job and is a first student to go up to camp for students from whom a team of mathematics Olympiad which will represent India will be selected. The journey up to camp is not a easy job, at level one student need to face RMO one of the tough exam of its own kind. But Aditya cracked this even when, he was at 10th while studying in Bal Shivaji High School Akola, Don't think due to this exam he reduced his percentage of tenth board examination he was topper from boys and mostly second in state with 98.8% marks in SSC.

He continued his interest in mathematics and went for preparation of Olympiad and this year also he did well and got selected for RMO, when he appeared for Indian National Mathematics Olympiad his teachers were quite confident about his success as he was ranked 18th in very prestigious exam called as NMTTC (National Mathematics Talent Context) which is organized by AMTI (Association of Mathematics Teacher's of India).

As per result declared on 12 March 2015 on HBCSE Aditya was selected for camp, he was one of five from Maharashtra and one of 32 from all over India. This selection is based only on performance in exam and is without any constitutional reservation or state reservation these are top 32 brains of Mathematics from India.

After camp of 30 days six students will be selected to represent India for Mathematics Olympiad which will be held at Thailand. The only Olympiad in which India gets large number of medals every year. In last five years India gained 3 gold, 8 silver and 9 bronze.

Even though there is no special award for these students as all of them say Mathematics gives them all joy but National Board of higher Mathematic give a scholarship of 48000/- per year till their graduation and they also get KVPY scholarship worth 80000/- per annum including contingency of 20000/- All students who clear INMO get direct admission to CMI (Chennai Institute of Mathematics) or IISER (Indian Institute of Science Education and research) or even ISI (Indian Statistical Institute).

The most important is he is first student of Akola to get selected for camp and we all students of Mathematics just wish to say Good luck to represent India.
